2020 lihtc round one awards

Colorado Housing and Finance Authority (CHFA) is pleased to announce the 2020 round one Low Income Housing Tax Credit (LIHTC) awards. In this round, 29 applications were received seeking a total of \$35.3 million in LIHTC. CHFA is awarding \$16.1 million in federal 9 percent LIHTC to 14 developments, which will support the construction of 940 affordable rental housing units. These developments will be built in various parts of Colorado including the Denver metro area, northern and southern Front Range, mountain communities, and San Luis Valley.
